

## BENTLEY CE PRIMARY SCHOOL TIMETABLE FOR VIRTUAL SCHOOL

8.45am	<b>Read a story</b> One member of the house reads out loud. We recommend a chapter book for Year 1 and older. For younger children read a different picture book each day.
9am	<b>Maths activity time</b> Set by the teacher and may be online.
9.30am	<b>Mental maths</b> For Year 1 upwards this should include regular TT Rock stars (please contact the office if your child cannot remember their login details). This includes tables practise and tests. Our in school tests are all about speed and fluency so no other tests are needed.
9.45am	<b>English reading</b> This can be reading to your child for early readers as well as them reading aloud to someone. For older children they may want to read silently, but should still talk about their reading and read out loud too for 5mins each session.
10am	<b>Break time</b> Get out in the fresh air wherever possible. Have a snack – at school this is fruit, water or milk or a piece of bread.
10.15am	<b>English activity</b> Handwriting practice using the school expectations. For Year 1 upwards this should include spelling practise and tests. Look on the school website for the expected spellings for each year group.
11.15am	<b>Other subjects</b> – see long term plan on the website Use online learning or teacher tasks
12pm	<b>Lunch and free time</b>
1pm	<b>Physical exercise</b> Get outside as much as possible in the garden. See our PE top tips on the website.
1.30pm	<b>Afternoon learning</b> Mon – music, use Charanga following the long term plan Tues – watch Newsround or Blue Peter Wed – French, set by Madame Jones Thurs – RE, set by teacher Fri – Own hobbies choice for Pick and Mix time
2pm	<b>Creative time</b> This is down to the resources you have at home; painting, drawing, sewing, design technology, cookery
3pm	<b>Make a difference time</b> E.g. set the table for tea, cook together, vacuum, help to wash up, empty the dishwasher, write a letter or email to grandparents etc. This is down to your family expectations and may need some help initially to example what to do and in setting up a rota.
