When we arrived we were met by the whole school!






Sadly, the school had not had food to provide lunch. Everyone was excited to see the food being unloaded. The cooks got to work to make lunch!

The fences have helped the garden to grow without animals eating the vegetables




We could see the water pipe working well and saw banana plants, tomatoes and rows of onions
